5. YOYOGI NATIONAL STADIUM (2ND GYMNASIUM)

The Yoyogi National Stadium (国立代々木競技場 Kokuritsu Yoyogi Kyōgi-jō) is an arena in Yoyogi Park, Tokyo, Japan which is famous for its suspension roof design. It was built between 1961 and 1964 to house swimming and diving events in the 1964 Summer Olympics. A separate annex (2nd gymnasium) was used for the basketball competition at those same games, which is a bowl-shaped structure with a magnificent cone-shaped ceiling. The 1st arena holds 13,245 people and is now primarily used for many important sport events on national, international and world levels, as well as many musical concerts, and many other different events.


